To show a photo, please follow these simple guidelines:

- Photography subject matter is limited to Milwaukee County's Lake Park
- One entry per photographer
- Photograph must be the work of the entrant
- Entrant must be age 16 years or older
- If individuals are represented in the photo, they cannot be identifiable
- Submit an 8 x 10 photo to North Point Lighthouse Museum at 2650 N. Wahl Ave. on July 9 or 10 at the front desk between 1-4 p.m. OR on July 15 between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- Include this information with photo:
 - First and last name of photographer
 - Address, Phone & email
 - Location of photo
 - Title or short description of the photo
- After the exhibit, photos can be picked up at the front desk on July 17 between 1-4 p.m. or July 18 between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
